1. Personnel:

- Performed Lt. Trent Tegen's 6-month Review.
- We are currently at full staff with no one out on conflagration.

2. Volunteers:

- The Volunteer Appreciation BBQ recieved rave reviews. Thanks to all that helped with putting it on. Good time was had by all!
- 5 volunteer cadets start the Joint Fire Academy in September with Corvallis FD.
- Attended Gary Cox's Celebration of Life at Suburban Church.

3. Apparatus Update:

- Head sets have been installed on the two tenders per the budget.

4. Equipment Update:

- We received \$10,000 from the Siletz Charitable Grant toward the purchase of our new Zoll Monitors. This was half of what requested. Need to discuss how we want to proceed with the purchase.
- Have not heard from FEMA if we have received the AFG Grant for the training tower.
- Purchased the new hose tester per the budget. Annual hose testing resumes.

5. Building Update:

- Had some door work done on the trailer at Station 202 that wasn't closing right.

6. Meetings:

- Hosted the UAB and EAB meeting for the 911 Service District.
- Attended Blodgett-Summitt board meeting and discussed a new fire station and providing Resident Volunteers to them.
